
3. Overall Impact & Conclusion




Initiative 7


The Hybrid Library provides:



Initiative 17


Coffee with Collector & MSME Clinic – Strengthening Government–Professional Interface





Enclosed please find a request dated 23rd September, 2025 from the Jalgaon Branch of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) regarding extension of Tax Audit, ITR filing and other compliance due dates for AY 2025-26. The request is self-explanatory.

ICAI in their request has stated that due to non-audit filing spillover, tax audit due date hardship, technical & portal issues, GST related burden due to recent revised rates, festive season and human limitation, there is urgent requirement for extension of statutory due dates relating to Tax Audits, Income tax Returns and other compliances for AY 2025-26.

I shall be grateful if you kindly look into the matter and arrange to –

- (1) Extend the Tax Audit Report (Form 3CA/3CB/3CD) and ITR filing due dates for AY 2025-26;
- (2) Provide relaxation in other statutory compliance deadlines falling in this period and
- (3) Ensure timely release of GST Annual return utilities to avoid last-minute hardship.
